Memorial Candles Requests 2026

Votive candles are located in the Most Sacred Heart alcove in the church. Candles burn in silent prayer in memory of those who have gone home to the Lord. If you would like a candle in memory of someone special. They are available to burn for one calendar year and can be renewed in subsequent years. The first year from January through December is \$225, and \$200 to renew thereafter. If purchased mid-year, the amount is prorated. Each candle is provided with a brass plate with a personalized inscription that you furnish. Inscriptions are limited to 2 lines with 20 characters per line. Characters include the spaces between words.

Example Headings: In Memory of = 12 spaces; and: In Honor of = 11 spaces
